Specifications:

- ➤ Individual landscaping and decorating shall be limited to 3ft area surrounding or adjoining the unit.
- Any resident desiring to plant trees or materially alter the area surrounding their unit must obtain written permission from the Association. (See attached approved trees)
- > River stones are acceptable in the 3 foot area but small white stones should not be added.
- Newly planted trees and shrubs must be no taller than <u>four feet</u> in height, and maintained so that the growth <u>does not exceed five feet</u>. Plants that grow over <u>two feet</u> are not allowed under a window. A one (1') foot space must be maintained between the planting and the exterior of the unit. It is the responsibility of the resident to maintain all 3ft area plantings and regularly trim all plants and shrubs below the maximum height and distance from the unit.
- ➤ Plants or trees on the side of units can be taller but must be neatly maintained, trimmed away from the building and not extended over or on the roof.
- > Bedding materials shall be top soil, mulch or other soft material.

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- Figure 2 Ground cover such as ivy, pachysandra, or climbing vines of any type is prohibited, as they tend to provide a haven for rodents.
- Edging stones or other material delineating the *3ft. area shall not exceed 4"* above ground level, and should be an <u>earth tone color</u>.
- No planters shall be hung from soffits, gutters or leaders.
- Live plantings may only be hung from a shepherd's crook (hook).
- You should not add any chemicals (fertilizer, weed killers, grub or insect control, etc.) to the area beyond the 3ft adjacent to the unit without the written approval of the grounds supervisor, as these chemicals may interfere with the ongoing village programs.
- > Anyone other than the resident should have a certificate of insurance on file for the work performed.

Any detailed description for work shall follow with this permit to be approved.

- Bed should be no more than 3 feet out from the porch slab.
- Finished bricking must be minimum of ½ inch below porch slab and conform to the existing grade.
- Edging must be 4 inches above the finished bricking.
- Bricks should be set in a 3 inch sand base.
- Garbage can must stay in original location.
- Acceptable colors for bricks and edging are earth tones, terracotta red, gray & tan.
